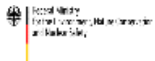

- **20 countries** committed to introducing National Urban Mobility Policies and/or Investment Programs (NUMPs)

5 main funders

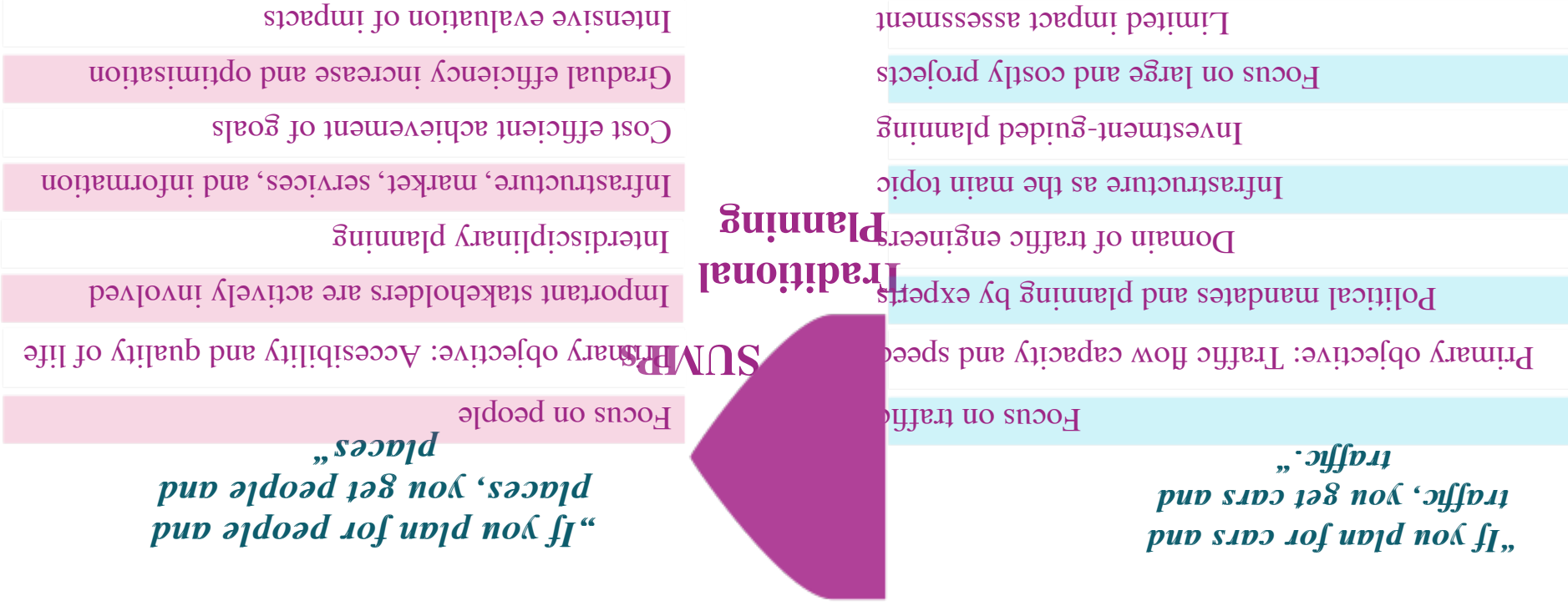
EUR 48 million in core TA delivered through 5 implementing agencies



Initial 2 NUMPs and 7 SUMPs prioritized and prepared EUR 26 billion capital investment

Mobilized EUR 435 million - EUR 66 million for 7 SUMPs and EUR 369 million for NUMPs in the Philippines, Ecuador and Dominican Republic

The Difference: Traditional Transport Plans and Sustainable Urban Mobility Planning (SUMPs)



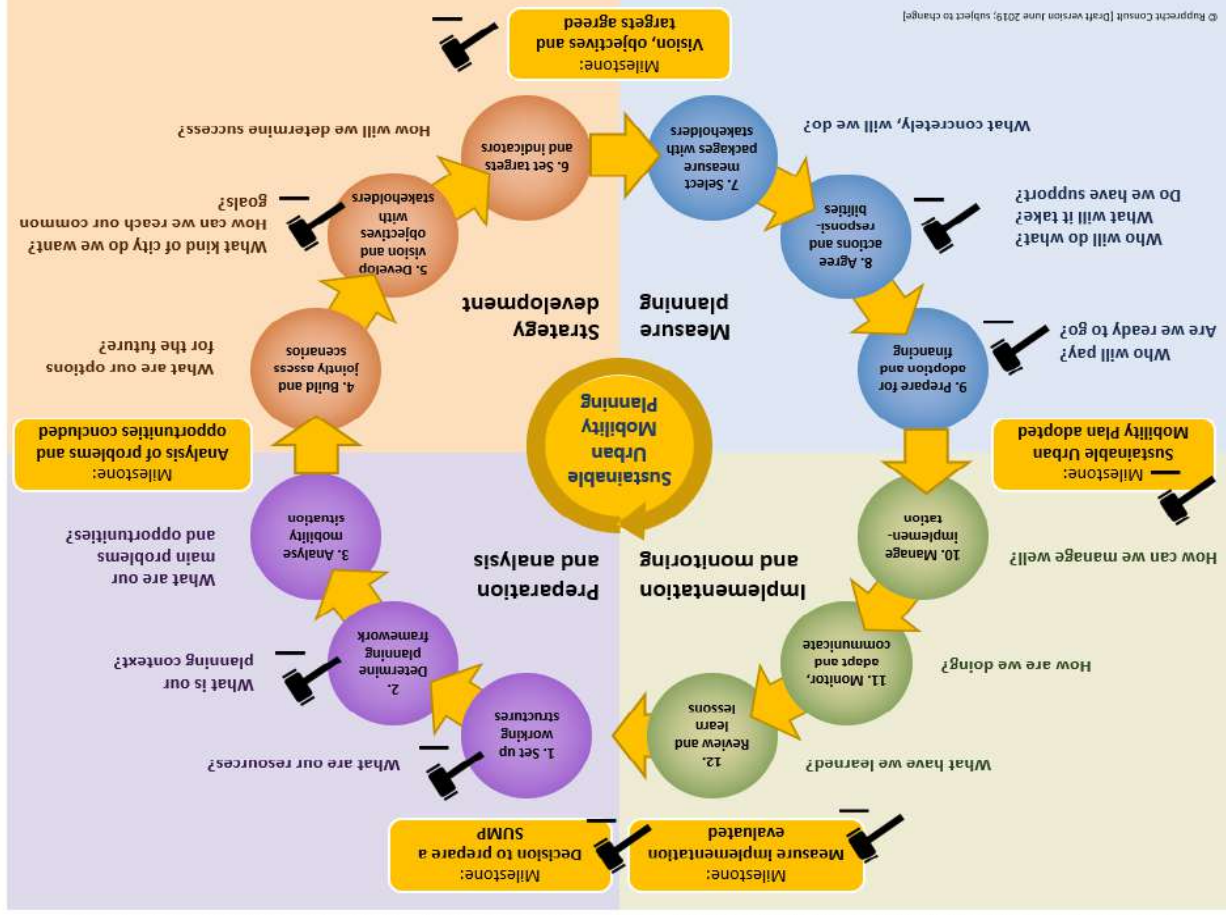

Fundamentals of the MobiliseYourCity Partnership

- **Strengthens Capacities and Offers SUMP/NUMP Implementation Support:** Provides proven approaches for the preparation of urban mobility policies for the city level and national level (called SUMPs and NUMPs) and facilitates collaborative learning and building a strong community of practice

- **Access to Finance** through our financing partners AFD, KfW, EBRD and ADB (through an MoU with AFD) and through national government subsidy programs

- **Bridges climate and development** by focusing on issues of accessibility, air quality, affordability, as well as mitigation

- **Building and maintaining partnerships:** Connects donors – implementers – national governments – cities to coordinate activities for low carbon and sustainable mobility



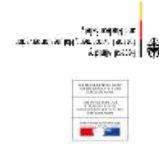
